

Granites and Marbles of Mauritania (GMM)



GMM (Granites et Marbres de la Mauritanie), a subsidiary of the SNIM group (holding 96% of the capital), is a company specialized in the extraction of ornamental stones, geological research related to construction materials, and the construction and operation of industrial facilities for processing and transforming construction materials.

Founded: 1998

Main Activities:

- Extraction and export of granite blocks
- Shaping and marketing of granite tiles
- Production of railway ballast and construction aggregates
- Paving works (pedestrian paths, parking areas) using granite or Atar sandstone pavers

Company History:

- **1998:** Company established to exploit granite and marble deposits in the Adrar region
- **2010:** Approval for the construction of a shaping plant to produce finished granite products (tiles and slabs)
- **2011:** Approval for the construction of a ballast and gravel manufacturing plant
- **2013:** Launch of both factories

Geographic Location: GMM operates across two main sites:

- **Quarrying operations** are managed by the quarry service based in **Choum**, where granite and marble deposits are primarily located in various sites throughout the Adrar region.

- The **head office and shaping plant** are based in **Nouadhibou**. This plant, commissioned in 2013, transforms raw blocks into finished products such as polished slabs and granite tiles.
